James M. Shaeffer, Sr. Ph.D. is the Founding Dean of the College of Continuing Education and Professional Development, at Old Dominion University (ODU). The College of Continuing Education and Professional Development was established in February 2014. As the Dean of the college, Shaeffer provides leadership in meeting the mission of providing high quality professional development and personal continuing education opportunities for nontraditional learners. The College serves as a primary entry point for businesses, industry, manufacturers, military, non-profits, and governmental agencies to the resources of ODU. Before joining ODU Shaeffer served as the first Associate Vice Provost for Outreach and Engagement at James Madison University. Prior to moving to Virginia, he held numerous positions at the University of North Dakota between 1996 and 2015, including the first CIO, Associate Vice President for Outreach and Dean of Continuing Education. In addition he served as the Director of the School of Extended Studies and Public Service at the University of Wyoming from 1992 -1996.

Shaeffer has a Ph.D. from Northwestern University and a Masters degree from Kansas State University, in addition to a Bachelor's degree from Iowa State University.
